Where are Pennsylvanians still exposed to smoke in the workplace?

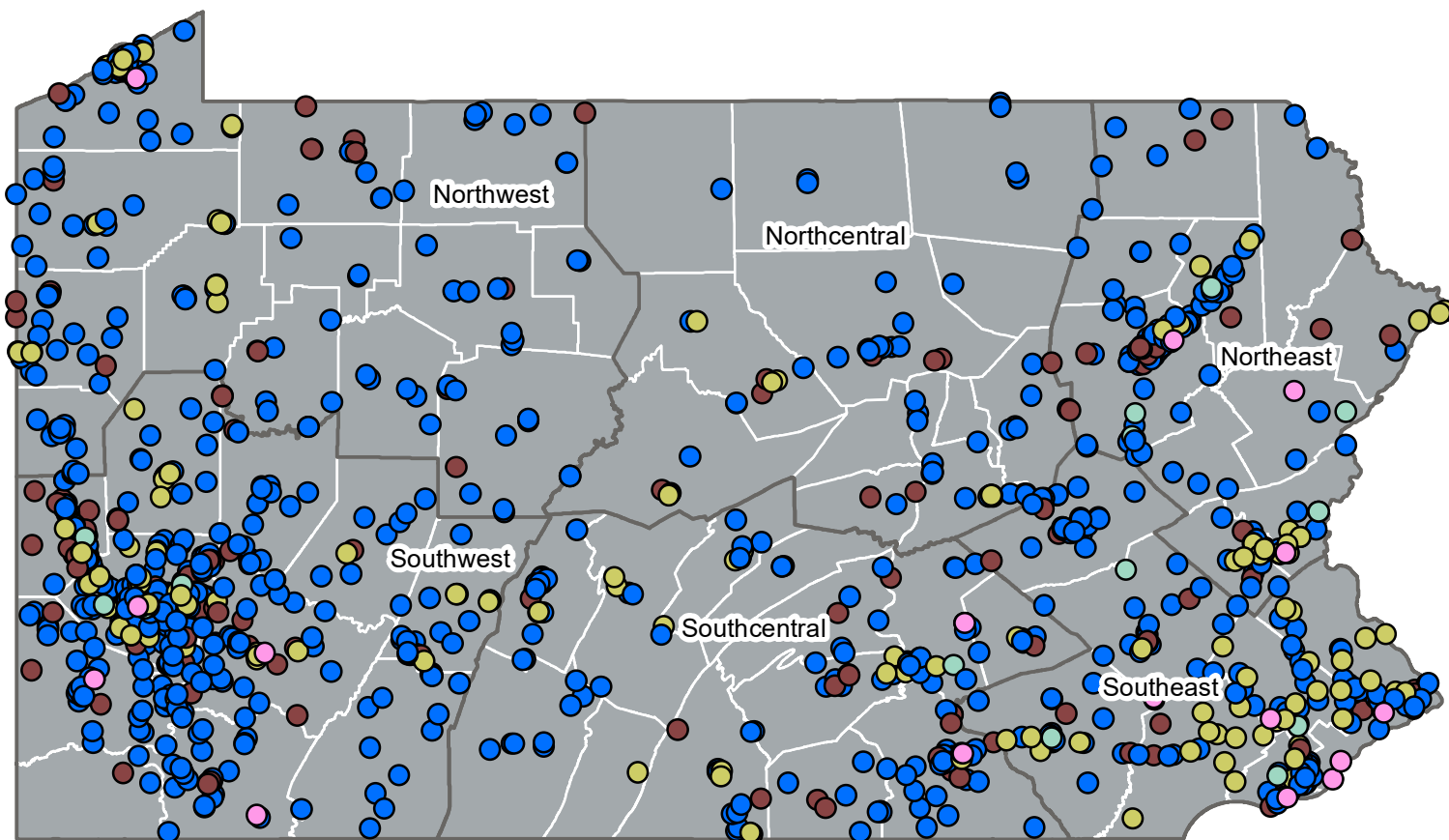
In 1,353 exempt venues throughout the state...

Exempt Venues

- Casino
- Cigar Bar
- Tobacco Shop
- Bar (Type I)
- Bar Attached to Restaurant (Type II)

* Data are recent as of December 2021. Application-based exceptions are included here, in addition to casinos. All Pennsylvania casinos have provided "proof of hardship" to receive exempt status. Additional venues that are exempt from the Act by definition (e.g. private clubs) are excluded.

The Southwest district has the most exempt venues (n=503), with more than double that of any other health district.

Notes: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, casinos became temporarily smoke-free as of June 2020. While some casinos have decided to remain smoke-free, others are once again permitting smoking on the gaming floor. They are included on the map due to their typical status under CIAA. Other venues may also have altered smoking rules during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Venues with unrecognized addresses have approximate locations based on nearby intersections when possible. 100% of venues statewide have been mapped. Symbols of neighboring venues may overlap.
